



Conditions of entry

2023 "Picnic in the Park" Fun Dog Show

ENTRIES WILL BE TAKEN ON THE DAY FROM 12pm AT THE DOG SHOW ARENA. CLASSES START FROM 2PM

The organisers, judges, stewards and helpers disclaim all liability for damage, theft, accident, injury or loss to persons, animals and property caused before, during or after the events in this schedule.

It costs £2/class to enter the dog show.

All dogs must be kept on a lead and under strict control.

The decision of the judge is final and cannot be challenged.

If necessary, the number of entries in any class may be split, restricted, or amalgamated at short notice.

All dogs are entered at the owner's risk.

No person shall carry out punitive or harsh treatment towards any dog at any time.

Please do not enter bitches in season to the dog show.

This is a "fun" dog show...please enter in that spirit!

The organisers reserved the right to refuse entry.

All entrants should gather at the arena from 1.50pm.

ALL DOG OWNERS/HANDLERS MUST CLEAN UP AFTER THEIR DOG FOR THE SAFETY AND WELL BEING OF EVERYONE ATTENDING THE EVENT.

Schedule of Classes

2023 "Picnic in the Park" Fun Dog Show. Classes paraded/judged from 2pm

CLASS 1: Most handsome boy dog over 12 months old

CLASS 2: Prettiest Bitch (girl dog) over 12 months old

CLASS 3: Cutest puppy under 12 months old

CLASS 4: Best dog with a junior handler (Child must be 12 or under and accompanied by a responsible adult)

CLASS 5: Waggiest tail

CLASS 6: Dog which most resembles its owner!

CLASS 7: Best trick performer!

CLASS 8: Best Old Sea Dog (Veteran – Bitch or Dog aged 8+)

CLASS 9: Scruffiest mutt

CLASS 10: Best in show (Judges Favourite)
Winners in all previous classes qualify for "Best in Show".
